From the age of 5, it was clear that Aurielle had a passion for music

and the gift of song. Aurielle's first vocal interest was sparked by the musical "Annie", and after watching "The Phantom of the Opera", within 2 years, her direction and commitment to Classical Opera were solidified. Aurielle began taking formal Operatic Training at age 7, and within 10 months she was readily recognized as a talent within the industry, and went on to win "1st Absolute Prize" and "Exceptional Young Talent" in a prestigious international competition, "Grand Prize Virtuoso", in Salzburg, Austria - the birthplace of W.A. Mozart - making Aurielle one of the Youngest Operatic Vocalists on record, both domestically and internationally.

Aurielle was also recognized and awarded in the "American Protégé International Vocal Competition" and was invited to perform at Carnegie Hall in December 2018.
