Chunyi Zhou, thirteen-year-old violinist, moved from Cambridge, England with her family in 2015.

Having studied the violin in the UK for 2 years, she soon took up studying with her current teacher, Linda Rose.

Chunyi was a featured performer on NPR's radio program 'From the Top' as a soloist with the Los Angeles Philharmonic, conducted by Maestro Paolo Bortolameo in March, 2018. She was also the recipient of the Greater Los Angeles ASTA Finals Grand Prize winner.

Miss Zhou has won numerous other competitions, including 1st place in the JCM/CAPMT Concerto competition 2017, 1st place in the Classics Alive Young Artist Auditions 2017, and 1st place in the Redlands Bowl Young Artist competition 2016. 1st Place winner of the Orange County 2016 Area ASTA Competition and subsequently the 1st Place winner of the Great Los Angeles 2016 ASTA Finals. Most recently, Chunyi won Parness Concerto Competition/Culver City Symphony Orchestra and it is a honor to play with Culver City Symphony Orchestra.

Chunyi attends Jeffrey Trail Middle School in Irvine, California, and will be attending the eighth grade. Aside from violin, her academic pursuits include mathematics and science. She is part of her school's Science Olympiad team and MATHCOUNTS team, participating in the National Science Olympiad Tournament as well as earning distinctions in several American Mathematics Competitions.
