Nathan Gendler was born in July 2006 in Los Angeles, where he began his violin studies

at age 3 and currently a 7th grader at Ad Astra School, Hawthorne.

In 2012 he had his orchestral debut in Germany, a year after he studied with Prof. Michael Tseitlin and later performed at Stradivarius Society in Chicago and was loaned a very fine Italian violin.

His accomplishment and appearance including solo performance with Palisades Symphony in 2017 after winning the competition, scholarship from Westside Committee of the Los Angeles Phil and 2nd prize winner on 2018 Gail Newby Concerto Competition.

Last summer he participated in Heifetz PEG (Program for the Exceptionally Gifted) and recently held a solo recital in Manhattan, New York where he studies the violin with Patinka Kopec, viola and violin faculty of Manhattan School of Music.
